#### Judge's Comments on the Exhibition

When I first arrived on judging day, I carefully looked through each section to get a benchmark of the overall standard.

You may have thought I was fairly quick with the scoring, particularly in the Open section but I am used to sitting down and looking through lots and lots of images in various exhibitions and I can immediately pull out the ones that come to the top. When I turned round after the Open section and saw all the 5s on the print stands I thought 'what a good representation of a club.' There were some fabulous images in there and I'm hoping that all the visitors to your Exhibition really enjoy looking at the prints. The standard was really, really good. Probably not so many portraits and not so many sports/ action images, so I can see where your enthusiasms lie, but I really have been impressed overall. Some of the images lost out on print quality and some just needed a little bit of cropping in places – just minor things. Also, some of the ones that didn't make it were not quite sharp enough, or had weaker composition. Sometimes the choice of paper didn't quite suit the final image, which can make a difference.

My final choices have potential to do really well on the competition/exhibition circuit in Yorkshire and the UK.

It was a pleasure to be asked to judge this prestigious Exhibition, and I look forward to seeing the fabulous prints on display in the City. My thanks to all the organisers for all their help and slick management of the judging process.


Winner of the **Record Cup** for Best Record Print 171 **Fireplace, Bamburgh Castle** by Gerry Sweetman

It creates an emotional response from me, particularly how the shadow is reflected on the wall, and the lovely, thoughtful expression on the soldier. I think this one will do exceptionally well in external competitions."





Winner of the **Ron Harrison Trophy** for Best Small Print 173 **The Bathroom** by Richard Hall LRPS CPAGB BPE1\*

**Judge's Comments:-** "In a small print, what I'm looking for is quite a lot of information. It's one of my favourite categories when I come to visit Sheffield's Exhibition. I just love the colour palette in this, and the printing is of exceptional quality. We have managed to get, in a small area, a full bath and a sink. Well done."



Winner of the **Sweetman Trophy** for Best Monochrome Print 166 **The Dying of the Light** by Gareth Morgan

**Judge's Comments:-** "I chose this print as it conveys so much drama. By deciding to print in monochrome, the photographer has chosen the best medium to give us a glimpse back in time. I thought the balance of light and shade had been expertly managed. This was another one that stood out amongst some of the other excellent contenders for the award."
