Who can enter?

What is the age limit for entries?

There are two categories of entry.

Those aged 18 and under on the 1st April 2025

Those aged 19 and over on the 1st April 2025.

How many photos can I enter?

Just one photo of your choice.

Can I use a photo from a smart phone?

Yes. You can use any image from any type of camera.

How will the successful images be chosen?

The successful entries will be chosen by our President and two other members of Sheffield Photography Society.

Is there a cost?

There is no cost to entering your photograph and you will also have a chance to win a £25 voucher to spend on photography.

Will my image be shown on social media?

With your permission, we will be post your image on our Facebook & Instagram pages so even if you do not win a print and exhibition slot, your picture will be available on line for people to see and admire.

Information for Entries.

Anyone who lives or works in Sheffield can enter one image each.

We have two categories.

1 Submissions from members of the public who will be aged 18 and under on the 1st April 2025.

2. Submissions from members of the public who will be aged 19 and over on the 1st April 2025.

The picture can be taken on any type of camera including from a smart phone.

The picture can be of any subject and style, including using creative techniques such as slow shutter speed, intentional camera movement and multi exposures.

Computer manipulated images are permitted. All manipulation of the image shall be carried out by the author, or under his or her direct control. Computer Clip-Art, internet copyright free images or graphics from any other sources are not permitted.

SPS has the right not to accept any submission if we consider the subject matter to be inappropriate for display in the exhibition.

By entering you are agreeing that the image submitted was taken solely by you on a camera and you have not used Artificial intelligence to create the image.

The file size of the image sent to us should not exceed 5 MB. If you are successful and we are going to print and display your image, then we may ask you if you have a bigger file size available.

If your image is chosen but we are unable to print it because it does not have sufficient pixels then your image will be disqualified.

By submitting your entry you give us permission to post it on social media and in general publicity, including the local press.

In all circumstances we will acknowledge you as the author. If you are under 16 years we will need written authorisation from your parent or guardian to accept your entry and their agreement on what level of posting and publicity they would agree to.

As author you will retain all copyright to the image.

We can print and mount the successful images if you would like us too, or you can arrange for your own printing and mounting. We will provide details of the measurements for printing and mounting to the successful entrants.

The winning entries will be able to keep the mounted print and will receive a £25 voucher. All entries must be received by SPS before 1st March 2025.
